WCMBHA of BC is looking for other cities to facilitate leagues in their cities. The cost to become a member of WCMBHA of BC, is \$11.00 per player, which includes insurance, clinic courses, provincials, western championships, nationals and new to last year is Team Canada.

We have start up kits, and will assist with training coaching, staff, goalies and referees. Being part of ball hockey is like being part of a family, communication and values. This will allow kids and parents to be together as a family, therefore keeping strong family values during the children's upbringing.
